Mayor Galliher called the meeting to order and asked for a moment of silent prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Nash.

ROLL CALL OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

PUBLIC SAFETY – DONALD MEIER, CHAIRMAN – No Report.

PUBLIC WORKS – TOLBERT ROWE, CHAIRMAN

Approved request from Leadership Sedalia for the placement of 2 plaques in City right-of-way for their “Footsteps of George Whiteman Corridor” project (1 plaque on West 32nd next to Memorial Park Cemetery; 1 plaque in front of his mother’s home located at 623 West 24th) on motion by Meier, seconded by Driskell. All in favor.

Awarded proposal for Architectural Services for the planning and design of improvements to the Council Chambers to Louis G. Chiodini, Inc. d/b/a Chiodini Associates aka Chiodini Architects, St. Louis, MO on motion by Turley, seconded by Meier. All in favor except Stevenson who opposed. Councilman Stevenson stated that the City should stay local when bidding jobs and not keep getting out of town bids.

All in favor.

Councilman Cunningham commented that former Councilman Harold Jackson passed away on February 1, 2015.


GOOD & WELFARE:
