The Council of the City of Sedalia, Missouri duly met in special session on Monday, June 22, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. in the Mayor's Conference Room at the Municipal Building with Mayor Stephen J. Galliher presiding.

BILL NO. 2015-88 , ORDINANCE NO. 10339 – AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ACCEPTING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEDALIA, MISSOURI AND THE SPAY & NEUTER CLINIC, LLC FOR VETERINARY SERVICES FOR THE SEDALIA ANIMAL SHELTER was read once by title.

2nd Reading – Motion by Meier, 2nd by Nash. All present in favor. Cunningham and Turley were absent.

Final Passage – Motion by Meier, 2nd by Nash. All present in favor. Cunningham and Turley were absent. Councilman Turley arrived at 6:08 p.m. prior to roll call vote.

BIDS:


- Veterinary Services – Animal Shelter – June 11, 2015 (Opened June 12, 2015)

City Administrator, Gary Edwards commented that work has started on the budget for the Animal Shelter. Police Chief, John Degonia introduced Andrea Martin, new Animal Shelter Manager and added that the City will be taking control of the shelter effective July 1, 2015.

Councilman Cross commented he would like to see the ordinance amended to reflect that if a cat’s left ear is nipped it has been spayed and/or neutered and received shots and then returned back to the original place where the animal was picked up. Chief Degonia and Ms. Martin commented on a new process that will be implemented when an animal is adopted. A microchip will now be inserted in the animal that will allow the shelter to know who the owner is and Ms. Martin added that the shelter will be implementing a “Trap Neuter Release Program” that coincides with the new process if an animal is trapped.

The meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m. on motion by Meier, seconded by Nash. All present in favor. Cunningham was absent.
