BILL NO. 2015 – 123, ORDINANCE NO. 10374 – AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 48-52 TO ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 48 OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING FEES FOR COMPOST FACILITY PRODUCTS AND INCORPORATING SAID FEES INTO THE CITY’S FEE SCHEDULE was read once by title.


MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS FROM MAYOR/COUNCIL/ADMINISTRATOR:


GOOD & WELFARE: None.
