MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS FROM MAYOR/COUNCIL/ADMINISTRATOR:

Mayor Galliher stated that an outstanding job was done on the D.A.R.E car show on Saturday, April 2, 2016.

JoAnn Martin, Administrator of the Pettis County Health Center, thanked the Council for their dedication to improving the health of the community by passing the Sedalia Clean Air Ordinance. Ms. Martin stated that per current statistics, Pettis County Residents who smoke have declined from 29% in 2013 to 23% in 2016; Overall health ranking in state of Missouri shows that Pettis County is now ranked 51st in 2016 compared to 62nd in 2015 and Katy Trail Community Health shows decline in the number of patients using tobacco products.

Councilman Turley thanked Councilman Cunningham for his service to the community and added he would be missed. Mayor Galliher added that Councilman Cunningham was an asset to the City and the 1st Ward.


GOOD & WELFARE:

Barbara Debates, 1211 S. Ohio, voiced concern about the condition of the house next to her at 1215 S. Ohio owned by John Dick. Ms. Debates gave examples of the condition of the house, stating that the house's fence is falling down into her back yard, there is ivy growing from the house into her yard and homeless persons are living in the house. Mayor Galliher stated he would address the issue first thing tomorrow.

Terri Hunter, 24750 Dresden Rd., stated she knew that the rental inspection issue was not on the agenda, however, she would like to remind everyone that not every house in disrepair is a rental house and added that there needs to be enforcement of current ordinances that are on the books for all properties.

The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m. on motion by Driskell, seconded by Meier. All in favor.
