

You are invited to submit a Bid for the following goods and services: "EQ-1 IMPROVEMENTS, SEDALIA, MO - 2015." The work provides for improvements at the Wastewater Conveyance and Treatment facilities in Sedalia, MO. The work consists of improvements at three sites. The improvements at the Central Wastewater Treatment Plant consists of the construction of a new drain line from the existing stormwater equalization basin to the existing lift station, several improvements to structures with associated piping and valves complete with electrical/mechanical, SCADA system wiring and other items of miscellaneous work as shown on the plans or described in the specifications. The improvements at the North Wastewater Treatment Plant consists of the construction of a new equalization basin dewatering lift station, force main from the lift station back to the North Treatment Plant, several improvements to structures on the plant site with associated concrete work, piping and valves complete with electrical/mechanical, SCADA system wiring and other items of miscellaneous work as shown on the plans or described in the specifications. The improvements at the Southwest Lift Station consists of the construction of a new equalization basin dewatering lift station, force main from the lift station back to the Southwest Lift Station, several improvements to structures on the plant site with associated concrete work, piping and valves, the replacement of the Southwest Lift Station pumps, and an emergency generator complete with electrical/mechanical, SCADA system wiring, and other items of miscellaneous work as shown on the plans or described in the specifications. A pre-bid conference will be held on February 4, 2015 at 1:00 PM local time. The conference will be held at Sedalia's City Hall, 200 S. Osage, Sedalia, MO 65301. A tour of the project sites will immediately follow the meeting. Envelopes containing the bids shall be sealed and must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond in an amount of not less than five percent of the amount bid. The check(s) or bond(s) shall be made payable to Arlene Silvey, City Clerk for Sedalia, Missouri as security that the bidder(s) to whom the award(s) are made will enter into contract to build the improvements bid upon and furnish the required bonds and insurance.
