

INVITATION TO BID

You are invited to submit a Bid for the following goods and services: "PEAK FLOW MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENTS STORMWATER EQUALIZATION (EQ-2), SEDALIA, MO - 2015."

The project is briefly described as follows: The work provides for improvements at wastewater conveyance and a new stormwater equalization facility in Sedalia, MO.

The improvements consist of the construction of a new sanitary sewer line from the diversion structure to Equalization Basin 1, two new stormwater equalization basins (1.5MG concrete structure and 6.5MG earthen structure), new stormwater pump station, 30" force main from the stormwater pump station to Equalization 2, the associated piping and valves, new generator complete with electrical/mechanical, SCADA system wiring and other items of miscellaneous work as shown on the plans or described in the specifications.

A pre-bid conference will be held on Thursday, August 27, 2015 at 10:00AM local time. The conference will be held at Sedalia's City Hall, 200 S. Osage, Sedalia, MO 65301. A tour of the project site will happen immediately follow the meeting.

Envelopes containing the bids shall be sealed and must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond in an amount of not less than five percent of the amount bid. The check(s) or bond(s) shall be made payable to the Clerk/Treasurer, Sedalia, Missouri, as security that the bidder(s) to whom the award(s) are made will enter into contract to build the improvements bid upon and furnish the required bonds and insurance.
