

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Sedalia at the Office of the City Clerk in the Municipal Building, until 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, October 27, 2015, for the **MILL AND OVERLAY OF VARIOUS STREETS, Project 2015-06, dated October 13, 2015**, and will be publicly opened and read aloud in the second floor Conference Room. The work consists of base failure repair along with milling and removal of the existing asphalt/concrete surface and 2" surface mix asphalt overlay between curb lines; and all incidental and/or related work as necessary to provide a complete project.

Prevailing wage rates applicable to the above have been predetermined as required by State Law.

Copies of Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents for bidding purposes may be obtained at the Municipal Building located at 200 S. Osage, Sedalia Missouri. A twenty-dollar (\$20.00) non-refundable deposit is required for each set of plans and specifications.

All bidders are required to submit their proposal on the printed forms contained in the Contract Documents. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked on the outside "**MILL AND OVERLAY OF VARIOUS STREETS**" with name of bidder. The entire contract book must be bound and submitted with all necessary forms filled out and enclosed.

A bidders bond for the amount of 5% of the total amount of the bid made payable to the City of Sedalia must accompany each proposal.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any irregularities in the bids. No bidder may withdraw his or her bid for a period of sixty (60) days after date of bid opening.

The City of Sedalia hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
