Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Sedalia at the Office of the City Clerk in the Municipal Building, until 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, December 2, 2014, for the **MAIN STREET WEST LIFT STATION REHAB, Project 2014-10, dated November 13, 2014**, and will be publicly opened and read aloud in the second floor Conference Room.

The City of Sedalia is soliciting bids from regional contractors for work consisting of the installation of 2 pumps, 2 starters, 2 breakers, pump and electrical components and all incidental and/or related work as necessary to provide a complete project.

Copies of the Contract Documents for bidding purposes may be obtained at the office of the Public Works Director on the second floor of the Municipal Building, 200 South Osage Avenue. A twenty-dollar (\$20.00) non-refundable deposit is required for each set of plans and specifications.
