CITY OF SEDALIA ANNUAL “CLEAN SWEEP” PROGRAM BEGINS THE WEEK OF APRIL 13, 2020

(SEDALIA, MISSOURI) The City of Sedalia’s “Clean Sweep” Program begins Monday, April 13, 2020. We encourage residents to take advantage of this service to assist in cleaning any unwanted trash, bulky items and yard waste from their property. The City has been divided into 12 sections encompassing the entire area served by the City’s Sanitation Division. Beginning the week of April 13 and continuing through the week of July 6, 2020, each area will have a Clean Sweep event. No events are planned during the weeks of Memorial Day or Independence Day. The map and table below further describes these areas. The individual pick-up on demand service for a fee **will not be available** during the Clean Sweep Event timeframe, April 13 through July 6, 2020, but will be available the balance of the year. 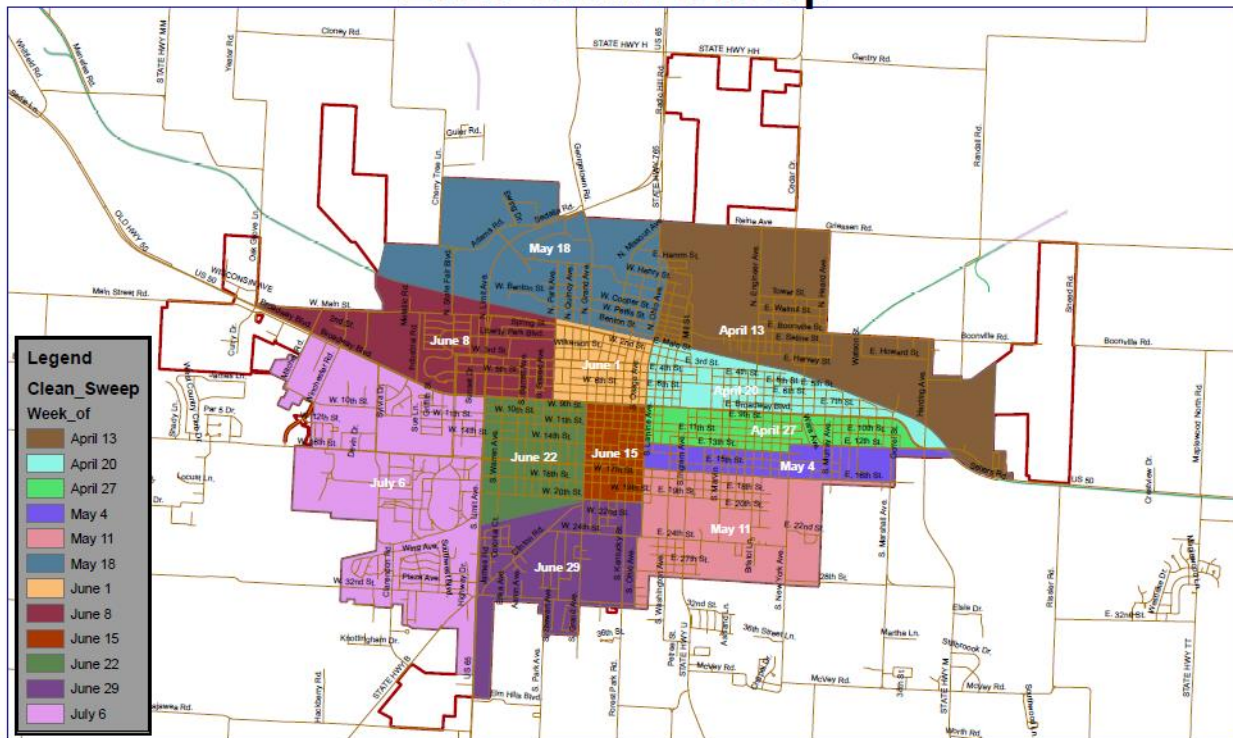
Each household may place up to 4-cubic yards of bulky waste and 4 cubic yards of yard waste in front of their residence for pick-up during the week of their Clean Sweep Event. Collection of more than 4-cubic yards of bulky waste and 4-cubic yards of yard waste from any residence will result in an additional charge of \$26 per cubic yard to those having additional materials for disposal. Pickup on demand service which is available during the balance of the year costs \$28.50 per cubic yard.

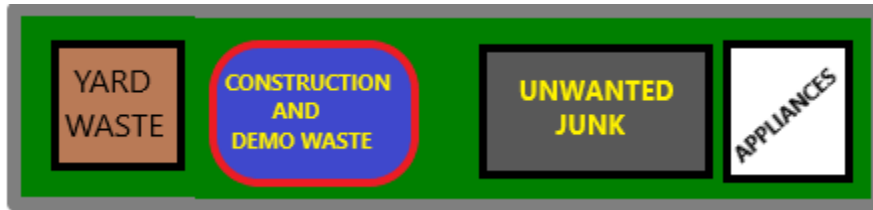

To assist in understanding how much material can be placed at the curb without incurring additional charges, 4-cubic yards is the equivalent of 2 standard pick-up loads or would fill the space shown in the truck photo below twice.



All materials will need to be placed at the curb or between the sidewalk and the street in the greenspace away from overhead lines and trees by 6:00 a.m. on the Monday of the Area's Clean Sweep Event Week. Sanitation crews will then spend the week collecting and disposing of the materials for that area. We are asking residents to place materials in segregated piles as shown in the diagram below.



The following definitions are provided to assist in determining in which area to place certain materials:

- Yard Waste including vegetation, plants, tree debris, such as branches and leaves, bushes, brush and tree stumps.
- Construction and Demolition Waste includes carpet, carpet pads, lumber, dry wall, siding, treated patio lumber, pallets, old windows and screen doors.
- Other Unwanted Junk includes old furniture, clothing, old magazines, newspapers, plastic toys, old patio furniture, bar-b- que grills, mattresses, etc.
- Appliances are banned from landfills in Missouri and will need to be segregated. Please keep any appliances such as refrigerators, washers/dryers, microwaves, ranges, window air conditioners, or dishwashers separated out.
