  - A. Dan Youngblood, 1315 S. Quincy, is requesting a four way stop at the intersection of W. 14<sup>th</sup> Street and S. Quincy Avenue. He has concerns about the intersection and the school children in the area. This request was tabled from the prior meeting so staff could collect additional information.
  - B. Gary Blake, 3257 Cunningham Drive, is requesting the stop signs be removed from Clarendon Rd. at Southwest Blvd. changing this intersection to a two way stop, stopping Southwest Blvd. only. The stop signs are not needed and interrupt the flow of traffic on Clarendon Rd. This request was tabled from the prior meeting so staff could collect additional information.
  - C. Jeff Lehman, City of Sedalia, 200 S. Osage Avenue, is requesting no parking around the curves in the Crescent Creek Addition, Crescent Creek Addition Park 2, Lehi Addition, and on Matz Circle. This will allow emergency vehicles to make the turns on the roads in these areas.
  - D. Greg Harrell, Sedalia Fire Department, 200 S. Osage Avenue, is requesting no parking on both sides of the proposed new road, Ammon Drive, around west and east curves, affecting the curves only. This will allow the fire truck to make the turns on the proposed road when it is constructed.
