CITY OF SEDALIA RECYCLING SERVICES CHANGE AND MOVE TO NEW LOCATION

(SEDALIA, MISSOURI): On June 20, 2016, Sedalia recyclers will begin implementing the first step in the City's single-stream recycling plan.

The Recycle Center on Metallic Lane will close and a new Materials Management Site will open at 27882 Highway U, the location of the City's Compost Facility. Relocation of the Recycle Center will allow for drop-off of not only recyclable materials, but also yard-waste and by appointment, household hazardous waste. The Materials Management Site will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. 7 days per week excluding City holidays. The recycle drop-off sites at Thompson Hills Shopping Center and at 10th and Massachusetts as well as the Materials Management Site will use only two containers.

One single stream container will be used for all plastics, aluminum, tin, paper including cardboard, newspaper and magazines. Glass will continue to be accepted in a separate container. Materials not accepted for recycling, include: Styrofoam, plastic wrap, thin plastic bags such as those used by grocery stores and big box retailers, diapers, liquids, medical waste, organic food products such as banana peels, lettuce, watermelon rinds, meat scraps or bones.
