July 1, 2015 was a day of new beginnings for both the Sedalia Animal Shelter and the Sedalia Police Department. While the SPD Animal Control Officers were familiar with working with the previous Humane Society Animal Shelter staff, July 1 would serve as the front page to an entirely new story as the Sedalia Police Department officially assumed responsibility for the welfare of Sedalia's lost pet population.

Animal Shelter Manager Andrea Martin said the anticipation was really high that first day. "You really don't know how people will respond to such a new change like this," said Martin, "but the month of July has just been amazing with all the community support that has been provided."

Andrea said citizen response has been remarkable. From donations ranging from monetary amounts, food and soap to countless community service hours, it is evident that Sedalia and Pettis County residents are interested in providing comfort to our furry friends. "I've especially noticed an increase in our kids wanting to help," said Martin, "whether it's through an organization like the Boy Scouts or simply a teenager who plans on only coming for one visit and then returns again and again."

For the month of July, the Sedalia Animal Shelter had a total of 41 adoptions. They were open 22 days and did not have one single day without an adoption! Staff was also able to return 22 dogs to their owners.

Downtown Streetscape Well Underway!

Phase IIIa of the Downtown Streetscape began on Monday, August 3, 2015. Plans for S. Ohio Avenue from 7th Street to Broadway Avenue include a new street, sidewalks, water lines, street lights and an arch north of the intersection of Ohio Avenue and Broadway. KAT Excavation was awarded the contract for \$750,648.62 and Notice to Proceed was given on August 3, 2015. Completion date is scheduled for October 31, 2015
