#### EV Owners May Explore, Recharge in Downtown Sedalia

Not so many years ago, a person would have to locate the nearest phone booth to place a call while away from home. Today, several generations have never even seen a phone booth.

The City of Sedalia will soon address a present day growing need stemming from (continued top right)

advanced technology by providing a charging station for electric vehicles in Downtown Sedalia. The new station will be located in the City owned parking lot at West Second Street and South Osage Avenue.

According to the agreement between the City of Sedalia and KCP&L, approved by the Sedalia Council at their February 1, 2016 City Council meeting, the City will pay a possible minimal fee for a 9 month period. KCP&L will cover the cost of construction then collect all proceeds from the electricity purchased by vehicle owners. Charging stations are currently available at Sedalia's Walmart at 3201 West Broadway Boulevard.

While a completion time or the exact location of the charging stations in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and Osage parking lot has yet to be finalized, the City looks forward to offering this service to our citizens and those who visit our city. Whether someone is attending one of Sedalia's various events, they've arranged a day trip or evening out, or they've purposefully included Sedalia on a lengthier route in order to "recharge," the owners of electric vehicles will certainly enjoy and remember the hospitality shown to them while in our city.

## Work Continues on Sedalia Sewer Project

24 feet below ground level near the southeast corner of S. New York Avenue and E. 28th Street, crews are pouring the floor for an overflow basin to be used during heavy rain events. The area of concrete pictured will be repeated 7 more times just to finish the floor alone!

The City's Yard Waste Facility previously housed in this location is still open in its temporary location further south and on the west side of S. New York Avenue. Future plans include moving the Yard Waste Facility to the City Compost Facility located at 27882 Hwy U.
