

We deliver efficient, quality municipal services, create opportunities for growth and protect the quality of life that makes our community a desirable place to live.




**City Clerk's Office**

- Issued 1,020 garage sale permits (207 were on-line)
- Answered 28,443 phone calls
- Processed 146 ordinances and resolutions



**Sedalia Regional Airport**

- 84,314 gallons of fuel sold (54,534 jet fuel/29,780 aviation gas)
- 11,496 gallons sold by self-service pump
- 11,000 operations (30 a day)
- 23 based aircraft



**IT Department**

- 1,227 helpdesk tickets = 1,422.5 hours
- Processed 888,070 emails
- Processed 49.4 Terabytes of Internet Traffic
- Blocked 29,705 Viruses and Malware
- Stored 38.2 Terabytes of Data



**Sedalia Animal Shelter**

- Adoptions – 502
- Transferred Out – 125
- Returned to Owner – 215
- 2016 – 802 Live Releases
- 2017 – 833 Live Releases
- AND 84% decrease in euthanasia - 0% for time and space!



**Parks and Recreation Department**

- 207 Adult Rec League Teams
- 2,366 youth in parks and rec sports leagues
- 421 Youth in Dance (new program in 2017)
- 31,790 Admissions to Park Pools




**Cemetery Department**

- 129 gravesites sold and 13 columbarium niches sold

**Sedalia Police Department**

- 6,625 traffic stops
- 31,204 dispatched calls
- 220 arrests of juveniles 17 & under
- 1,465 adult arrests



**Sedalia Fire Department**

- 1,864 emergency incidents:
  - 1, 213 emergency medical calls
  - 651 fire/rescue/hazardous condition
- 12 candidates graduated from 2017 Fire fighter I and II program (second year offered). To date, 5 permanent positions within the SFD have been filled with program graduates.



**Street Department**

- 390 blocks of streets resurfaced
- Patched 1,239 street cuts
- Swept 2,411 miles of curb
- Cleared 3 snow events – spread 388 tons of salt
- Maintained 1,193 trees
- Installed 1,425 signs



**Sanitation Department**

- Collected 16,747,780 lbs of refuse
- Serviced 7,536 refuse accounts
- 1,859 Pick Up on Demand
- 53 abatements
- 191 alleys repaired



**Water Pollution Control**

- Treated 1.25 B gallons of wastewater
- 38 miles sewer pipe cleaned
- Produced 4,914 tons of compost
- Sold 3,997 cubic yards of compost




