
### SAS Staff Pick

### Shelter Stats



**For the month of December, the Sedalia Animal Shelter had 44 adoptions (22 dogs and 22 cats). They returned 19 lost dogs back to their families and 1 cat.**

**For the year, the shelter adopted 519 pets, returned 251 lost pets back to their families and transferred 38 animals to rescue.**

**December was also their largest month for not only monetary donations but also donations of food, bleach, paper towels, blankets, etc. We are truly blessed to be supported by such a wonderful community.**
