Sedalia-Pettis County Residents to Benefit from Regional and Local Partnerships

The perfect combination of teamwork and communication can help accomplish many goals. This can be witnessed in different settings, from sporting events (last year's Kansas City Royals win, for example) to projects soon to occur in the Sedalia-Pettis County area in March and April 2016.

The City of Sedalia and Pettis County are active members of the Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission (PTRPC), an organization based out of Concordia, Missouri. Per PTRPC's website, www.trailsrpc.org, this Commission assists the counties of Johnson, Lafayette, Pettis and Saline and the cities within this area, "to promote and implement planning activities in the areas of economic development, homeland security, solid waste management and transportation."

PTRPC has helped the City of Sedalia bring two major services to our citizens; the Yard Waste Facility and the Recycling Center. The ability to receive grant funding from PTRPC helped the City purchase multiple pieces of equipment that are currently in use at both facilities.

Sedalia and Pettis County residents will soon have a way to safely dispose of their household hazardous waste at a facility located near the City's Compost Facility at 27882 Highway U. Those wishing to use this service will first need to contact Executive Administrative Assistant Ellen Cross to schedule an appointment: (660) 827-3000 x 158. Bed Races: 12:00 p.m. (Noon)




Lucky is the person who adopts Stitch, our Sedalia Animal Shelter Staff's March Pet of the Month.
