Spring is here! Birds are chirping and, for the City of Sedalia, the hum of big machinery is in the air. Enclosed is a snapshot of the many City projects currently underway, completed or close to completion.

Structural Work on Sedalia Trust Building



Just imagine, 1886 was the last time most Sedalians saw the interior framework of the Sedalia Trust Building! Thanks to funding authorized by Sedalia's City Council and the City's Central Business & Cultural District, this building will continue to be an integral part of historic Downtown Sedalia.



EQ-2 Site and Sewer Project

Work continues on the EQ-2 site (pictured above) located at the intersection of E. 28th Street and S. New York Avenue. The EQ-2 site is one of the components of Sedalia's \$30 million sewer project as required by Missouri DNR's consent order. The deadline is July 2016 and all indications show that the project will be finished on time.

At the April 18, 2016 City Council meeting, Council approved the contract with Chester Bross Construction to start repairs to various City streets, some of

which were effected by the sewer project. Upon notice from the City regarding award of contract, the contractor has 30-45 days to start repairs.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Facility

Yard Waste Drop Off Site

Many Sedalians are familiar with the location of the City of Sedalia Compost Facility, but soon this area will house not only the compost facility and household hazardous waste drop off facility, but also the yard waste drop off site. Preparations are underway for the yard waste drop off site to be located directly across the drive (south) of the household hazardous waste drop off site in an area to the right of your vehicle once you enter through the front gates. Estimated time for relocation of the yard waste drop off site is July 2016.
