IN THIS ISSUE

Several City of Sedalia facilities, including the Municipal Building at 200 S. Osage, have allowed measured public access since Monday, May 4, 2020. Listed below are some of the guidelines the City has in place:

City Municipal Building:

- Sneeze guards have been installed
- Tape markers have been strategically placed on the floor to provide for social distancing
- Chairs have been moved to provide for social distancing
- Pens will be rotated and disinfected between users
- Commonly touched surfaces will be disinfected regularly
- Court lobby will be limited to 3 people at a time. Restrooms in this area will be used to require everyone to wash hands as they enter. The doors will have signage to separate those having business with the court and those having other business in city hall.
- Disposable masks will be provided and encouraged at all times, and required at times where we cannot maintain social distancing of 6 feet.
- Access to upstairs will be by appointment only for the public.
- Signage is being installed to help maintain these precautions

City to Observe Memorial Day

The City of Sedalia will observe the Memorial Day holiday on Monday, May 25, 2020. Offices in the Municipal Building and the City's Materials Management Site at 27882 Highway "U" will be closed in observance of the holiday.

Weekly trash pickup for the week of May 25, 2020 will follow the normal collection schedule.

All City offices including the Materials Management Site will re-open for normal business hours on Tuesday, May 26, 2020.

Sedalia Regional Airport Terminal:

- Rotate and disinfect pens between different users
- Commonly touched surfaces will be disinfected regularly
- Masks will be available and encouraged for all individuals in the terminal
- Encourage social distancing of 6 ft. (note family units are not required to distance from each other)

Sedalia Animal Shelter:

- Sneeze guards have been installed.
- Rotate and disinfect pens between different users
- Commonly touched surfaces will be disinfected regularly
- Tape markers have been strategically placed on the floor to provide for social distancing
- No more than 5 members from the public will be allowed in the facility at one time.
- Masks will be available and required for individuals in the lobby.

Cemetery Office:


- Rotate and disinfect pens between different users
- Commonly touched surfaces will be disinfected regularly
- Masks will be available and encouraged for all individuals in the office
- Encourage social distancing of 6 ft. (note family units are not required to distance from each other)

The following facilities will continue limited access to employees only:

Sedalia Fire Department **Water Pollution Control**
Sedalia Police Department **Sedalia Water Plants**
Street Department

Sedalia Public Library: Per their April 29, 2020 press release, the Sedalia Public Library's drop box will be available starting Monday, May 4. The library plans to reopen to the public on May 11, 2020 with check in and check out of materials only and limited hours open.

Municipal Court: By the order of Honorable Paul Beard and pursuant to the mandate of the Supreme Court of the State of Missouri, the Sedalia Municipal Court remains suspended through May 15, 2020.

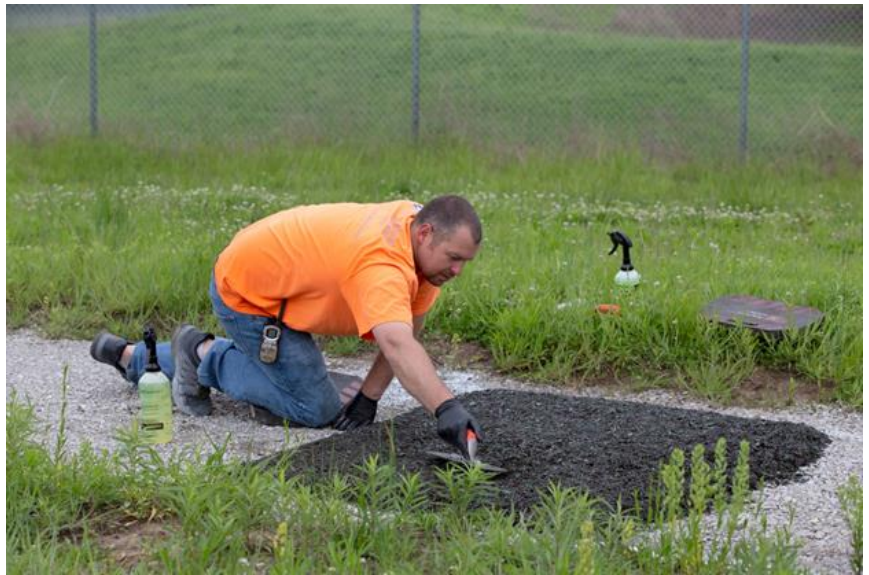
