THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY CITY OF SEDALIA TRASH AND RECYCLING PICK-UP SCHEDULE

The City of Sedalia will observe the Thanksgiving holiday on Thursday and Friday, November 23 and November 24, 2017. City of Sedalia offices including the Materials Management Site will be closed in observance of the holiday and no trash and recycling pick-ups will be made on those dates. Below is a detailed list of trash and recycling pick-ups affected by the Thanksgiving holiday period and the dates on which those affected pick-ups will be made.

During the Week of Nov. 20 – 24, 2017

If your trash and recycling is normally picked up on:	Your trash and recycling will be picked up on:
Tuesday	Monday -- Nov. 20, 2017
Wednesday	Tuesday -- Nov. 21, 2017
Thursday	Wednesday – Nov. 22, 2017
If your trash and recycling is normally picked up on Friday AND you live	Your trash and recycling will be picked up on:
North of 16 th Street	Tuesday, Nov. 21, 2017
South of 16 th Street	Wednesday, Nov. 22, 2017
<i>City offices are closed on Nov. 23 and 24, 2017. No trash or recycling pickups on these days.</i>	

During the Week of Nov. 27 – Dec. 1, 2017, all trash and recycling pick-ups occur on their regular days with the exception of an additional pick-up for those picked up on Friday.

Friday	Monday -- Nov. 27, 2017 AND Friday – Dec. 1, 2017

The Materials Management Site will reopen on Saturday, November 25, 2017 for normal business hours. All other City offices will reopen on Monday, November 27, 2017 for normal business hours.
