USE OF THE NEW CARTS WILL BEGIN ON NOV. 6.

On Sept. 7, the automated truck manufacturer notified the City of a delay in delivering the new trucks. Carts were delivered between Sept. 17 and Sept. 28 by the cart distributor and city crews are delivering carts to approx. 400 residences that were missed or wanted to exchange their carts for either smaller/larger carts.



COLLECTION DAYS AND ROUTES HAVE NOT CHANGED. PICK UP AT CURB UNLESS NOTIFIED BY HANG TAG ON DOOR.

Unless your home received a door hanger stating to continue using your current pick-up location, trash and recycling carts are to be placed at the curb. Carts should be placed at the curb or at the street with the lid opening toward the street on your collection day by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day and removed from the curb after emptying. As shown in the diagram to the right, space should be left between carts and other objects to allow for the garbage truck to easily pick-up the cart.

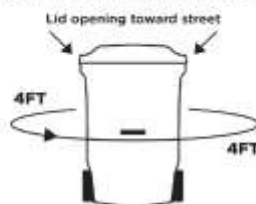
WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY OLD TRASH CANS?

Your old garbage cans can be repurposed for collecting yard waste, leaves, use around your garden, etc. After full implementation of the cart system (after Nov. 6, 2018), the city will schedule a pick-up day for residents having cans they no longer need. This date has not been scheduled yet, but we will be sure to send out a public service announcement prior to that date.

HOW DO I PLACE MY CART AT THE CURB OR ALLEY?

Place cart in proper direction and leave four foot spacing between other objects.

SOME STREETS IN SEDALIA WILL NOT ALLOW FOR COLLECTION TO OCCUR AT THE CURB OR STREET.

Homes in these neighborhoods will have a door hanger placed at the residence notifying them that their garbage and recycling collection point **will not** change as a result of the change-over to the cart system. A rear-loading garbage/recycling truck equipped with tipplers for emptying carts will be used in those areas where space is limited.

CARTS ARE BRANDED WITH SERIAL NUMBERS AND UPC CODES TO MAKE THEM EASILY IDENTIFIABLE.

Additionally, carts have embedded RFID tags that allow them to be located or tracked, if moved, from their delivery location.

October is Fire Prevention Month!
October 7 - October 13, 2018 is Fire Prevention Week.

Sedalia Fire Department staff met with Mayor John Kehde to proclaim October 7 - October 13, 2018 as Fire Prevention Week in the City of Sedalia. This year's theme for Fire Prevention is "Look. Listen. Learn. Fire can happen anywhere." The entire month of October is Fire Prevention Month.

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) suggests that all families review the following tips:

- **“LOOK”** for places fire could start. Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.
- **“LISTEN”** for the sound of the smoke alarm. You could have only minutes to escape safely once the smoke alarm sounds. Go to your outside meeting place, which should be a safe distance from the home and where everyone should meet.
- **“LEARN”** two ways out of every room and make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily and are free of clutter.
