STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS: CHIP AND SEAL CONTINUES

(SEDALIA, MISSOURI) The City of Sedalia will continue chip and seal on Sedalia streets next week. The following list provides the streets where improvements are planned for the week of July 16, 2018.

Date: Mon., July 16, 2018

Ware Ave. from E. 12th St. to S. Emmet Ave.
S. Washington Ave. from E. 16th St. to E. 24th St.
S. Ohio Ave. from E. 16th St. to E. 32nd St.
E. 31st St. from S. Ohio Ave. to the dead end

Date: Wed., July 18, 2018

S. Missouri Ave. from W. 16th St. to W. 24th St.
S. Quincy Ave. from W. 16th St. to W. 20th St.
S. Sneed Ave. from W. 16th St. to W. 20th St.
S. Beacon Ave. from W. 16th St. to W. 20th St.
W. 20th St. from S. Grand Ave. to S. Limit Ave.

Date: Thurs., July 19, 2018

W. 16th St. from S. Limit Ave. to S. Barrett Ave. east bound
W. 16th St. from S. Limit Ave. to S. Barrett Ave. west bound
W. 16th St. from S. Barrett Ave. to S. Park Ave.
N. Grand Ave. from W. Henry Ave. to N. Limit Ave.

Chip and seal places a coating of road oil on the existing city street followed by a layer of fine crushed rock. A roller is then run over the chips to embed some of them into the asphalt and hold the road oil in place. The layer of crushed chips including some loose chips remain on the street to prevent “bleeding” through of the oil to other surfaces, such as vehicles.

In areas where City crews are maintaining the roadway, motorists may expect delays due to lane restrictions and may want to consider using alternate routes.

We apologize for any inconvenience as we work to improve the streets in Sedalia. The work contained in this announcement is weather and equipment dependent, so changes may occur from time-to-time.
