Just One Month Until New City Sanitation Routes Begin!

The Sedalia Public Works Department has established new sanitation routes that will come into effect on October 3, 2016. A larger sized map is included in this newsletter on page 2. Citizens will also receive a paper copy of the map in their September water bills. The map will be available digitally on our City of Sedalia website; www.cityofsedalia.com and all citizens are welcome to contact Public Works for more information (660) 827-3000.

Traditionally, the City Sanitation crews have used Wednesdays as a day to do necessary equipment maintenance, etc. This day has been changed to Mondays. This change will actually make it easier for citizens to remember their trash service days as many national holidays occur on Mondays (for example, Presidents Day and Martin Luther King Day). By using Monday

as a City maintenance day, citizens will only need to remember changes in their trash pick-up for a handful of holidays. (As a reminder, the trash schedule for next week is adjusted per the current schedule due to Labor Day occurring Monday, September 5, 2016).

After October 3, 2016, residents are encouraged to have two trash containers, one marked "T" for trash and the other marked "R" for recycling. As an alternative, if only one container is available trash may be placed in trash bags and recycling materials in the container. We ask that you leave some space between the trash and recycling to assist our crews in identifying the different materials. City crews will pick up recycling first and then regular trash. 

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

The City of Sedalia utilizes single stream recycling, meaning all accepted materials (other than glass) may be placed in one container. We request that trash bags not be used! Below is a list of items that will and will not be accepted through the City's recycling services.

Clean balled aluminum foil (2" or larger) and pie pans	
Empty aerosol cans (no caps)	
Cans (do not crush or flatten)	
#1-7 plastic tubs, screw-top jars, bottles & jugs (no lids, no #7 PLA compostables do not flatten!)	
Loose metal jar lids and steel bottle caps	

Not Accepted for Recycling

CITY OF SEDALIA RESIDENTIAL E-WASTE/E-SCRAP COLLECTION

The City's new residential electronic waste or e-scrap drop-off service is now open and available at the Materials Management Site at 27882 Highway U in Sedalia. Residential electronic devices can be dropped off between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., 7 days per week excluding City holidays. The e-waste container is funded through a grant from the West Central Missouri Solid Waste Management District and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. Examples of items collected include: microwaves, personal computers (PCs), laptops, tablets, cell phones, printers, facsimile machines, keyboards, mice and cords, MP3 players, DVD and VCR players, video game consoles, stereos, radios and clocks. The number of "non-flat screen televisions" and "CRT-type computer monitors" accepted for disposal each month is limited due to the disposal cost (\$40+ per large unit) to the solid waste district, please contact Public Works at (660) 827-3000 ext. 158 to schedule drop-off of one of these units or to have your large unit picked up through the City's pick-up on demand service.

Most residential electronics can legally be discarded with household trash (i.e., municipal waste). Many people replace electronic devices as newer "technology" becomes available. If the electronic device is still operating as designed, we encourage you to consider donating the device to a local non-profit for redistribution or consider selling or trading in the device, before disposing or recycling of devices through the City's e-waste or pick-up on demand services. 4th Mosquito Spraying Event for 2016 Scheduled for September

Did you know that while you slept this summer, Public Works has had contractors spraying for mosquitoes? The 4th Mosquito Spraying of the season is planned from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on the following days (weather permitting):

Monday, September 12: From Broadway Boulevard south to the south city limits, from Ohio Avenue west to the west city limits.

Tuesday, September 13: From Broadway Boulevard north to the north city limits, from Ohio Avenue west to the west city limits.

Wednesday, September 14: From Broadway Boulevard north to the north city limits, from Ohio Avenue east to the east city limits.

Thursday, September 15: From Broadway Boulevard south to the south city limits, from Ohio Avenue east to the east city limits.

The City of Sedalia will be closed on Monday, September 5, 2016 in observance of the Labor Day holiday.

City trash collection for the week of September 5, 2016 will be adjusted as follows:

- *Trash normally collected on Monday will be collected on Tuesday
- *Trash normally collected on Tuesday will be collected on Wednesday
- *Thursday and Friday collection will occur as normal

Residents are encouraged to note the modified trash collection schedule and place trash curbside accordingly. City offices will re-open for normal business hours on Tuesday, September 6, 2016.

For the month of August, the Sedalia Animal Shelter had 53 adoptions (35 dogs and 18 cats). They transferred 6 dogs to Second Chance of Columbia. They also returned 17 dogs and 2 cats back to their homes. They had a total of 194 intakes, 74 dogs and 120 cats.

The Shelter had three off site events last month being the two doggie dives at each pool and an adoption event at Car-Mart. Their next adoption event is Saturday, the 17th of September, at Cricket Wireless.
