1. Review bids for two (2) police vehicles. This proposed expenditure is in the current fiscal year budget. The bids for two 2014 Dodge Charger police cars were opened on January 24th. Two of the bids met specs. A third bid did not meet specifications. Of the two bids meeting specs, one is from Warrensburg Dodge for \$52,594. The second bid meeting specs is from Bryant Motors of Sedalia for \$52,900. The difference in price is only \$306, but Bryant's is a local dealer. Because Bryant's is a local business, any future dealings with the dealer concerning these vehicles will be much more convenient for the City. The City of Sedalia police department has found Bryant's to be a reliable and trustworthy dealer. Staff is recommending that the bid from Bryant Motors be accepted.

PRE-COUNCIL MEETING – JANUARY 21, 2014

WORK SESSION

The Work Session started at 6:00 p.m. in the Mayor's Conference Room at the Municipal Building.

Council Members present were Stephen Galliher, Jo Lynn Turley, Rebecca LaStrada, Wanda Monsees, Wiley Walter, Bob Cross, Tolbert Rowe and Larry Stevenson.

Presentation – Blue Ribbon Steering Committee

Diane Simon, Chairman of the Blue Ribbon Steering Committee, thanked the Mayor and Council for their commitment to making Sedalia a Blue Ribbon community. Ms. Simon added that support involving the Citizens for Clean Sedalia, the Citizens Committee for Smart Growth, the Tree Board and the implementation of Sedalia as a Smoke Free Community, works to meet the Blue Ribbon Steering Committee's goals and this progress is important for the City's economic growth.

The Blue Ribbon Committee provides a framework for communication between the City, County, Economic Development, education and local organizations to help Sedalia thrive.

Accomplishments in 2013:

- Clean Air Sedalia – Smoke Free Ordinance passed June 2013
- Healthy Living Action Group – started 3rd year of Healthy U Class
- Adolescent Health Coalition – Teen outreach group started at Whittier High School
- Pettis County Breast Feeding Coalition – developed materials for distribution in 2014 on breast feeding at work.

Ms. Simon thanked the Parks and Recreation department for their outstanding job in adding programs that are free or of little cost to members of the community. The Arts and Recreation committee continues to support the growth of local arts and recreational opportunities. Ms. Simon added that there is a need for a community center and the Blue Ribbon Committee is ready to support the same when a feasible plan is completed.

Ms. Simon thanked the Mayor and Council for their support with the annual Fourth of July fireworks event held at the Missouri State Fairgrounds and stated that the Police and Fire Departments were instrumental in staging this successful event.

The Blue Ribbon Steering Committee continues to provide a \$500 scholarship for a local student to attend State Fair Community College and the applicants are required to submit an essay on community service.

The Blue Ribbon committees are Education, Local Government, Economic Development, Social Services, Health and Wellness, and Arts and Recreation, which all work together for the common goal of making Sedalia a Blue Ribbon community.

Cheri Heeren, with Blue Ribbon Steering Committee, presented brochures on the Pettis County Community Partnership on homeless rates in Pettis County and a resource directory to help people in these situations and to help prevent the same. Through the housing program from November 1, 2012 to November 1, 2013; 5,671 people were served (i.e. assistance with rent and/or deposits, mortgage payments, utility payments, transportation, food, books & materials, paper products, diapers, dishes and counseling).

Ms. Simon invited the Council to attend any of the Blue Ribbon Steering Committee meetings which are held the 3rd Thursday of each month a 3:30 p.m., at the Pettis County Community Partnership meeting room (behind K-Mart building).

COMMITTEE MEETING

Public Safety Committee – Councilman Galliher, Chairman – No Report.

Public Works Committee – Councilman Rowe, Chairman, presented the following recommendation:

- Ordinance amending Section 64-45 (a)(50) of the Code of Ordinances to allow for the manufacturing of armor piercing projectiles for rifle calibers only was moved to full Council on motion by Walter, seconded by Galliher. All in favor.
- Ordinance approving and accepting an agreement with Engineering Surveys & Services, LLC for services related to 12 stormwater projects not to exceed \$10,000 as detailed in the 2013 City of Sedalia Stormwater Master Plan was moved to full Council on motion by Walter, seconded by LaStrada. All in favor.
- Ordinance repealing Ordinance Number 9704 by changing the hours of a no parking restriction on school days only from 8:00 a.m. thru 4 p.m. Monday thru Friday to 7:00 a.m. thru 4 p.m. Monday thru Friday on the south side of East 6th Street between South Engineer and South Summit Avenues in the City of Sedalia, Missouri was moved to full Council on motion by Galliher, seconded by LaStrada. All in favor.
- Ordinance granting a rezoning application (from R-1, Single Family Residential to R-3, Apartment House District; for an 1,890 square foot duplex in addition to the 900 square foot single family residents located there) by Nathan Beard for property located at 310 South Harrison in the City of Sedalia, Missouri (there is neighborhood opposition to this rezoning and the Planning & Zoning Commission voted 4 to 3 to recommend denial of zoning request). Jan Bahner, 707 W. 3rd Street, spoke on behalf of several neighbors, stating that they opposed a rezoning and added that zoning borders are established for a reason. At this time, there are 8 units consisting of 2 single family homes, an apartment building with 4 units, and 2 rental houses. Ms. Bahner stated that this duplex could cause harm to the neighborhood and reduce the sense of safety. Nathan Beard, 1816 W. 4th Street, stated that \$120,000 has already been invested in the vacant lot in question and

believed people would support this. Mr. Beard stated he would like to withdraw the rezoning application. Councilman LaStrada suggested having the ordinance explained to property owners to avoid problems in the future. City Administrator, Gary Edwards, stated that the Planning & Zoning Commission meetings are held to discuss issues citizens may have with a rezoning application. City Attorney, Anne Gardner, stated that a zoning map is available on the City's website and it is up to the buyer to find out the current zoning and to contact City staff for a rezoning application process. Following discussion motion was made to accept Mr. Beard's withdrawal of rezoning petition by Galliher, seconded by LaStrada. All in favor.

- Proposal from Engineering Surveys & Services for services related to the design of the replacement of the sidewalk on the north side of Third Street from its intersection with Ohio east to the nearest alley in an amount not to exceed \$8,500 was moved to full Council on motion by LaStrada, seconded by Monsees. All in favor.
- Proposal from Engineering Surveys & Services for services for the design of the replacement of the sanitary sewer located in the alley between Lamine and Osage from 7th to Broadway in an amount not to exceed \$8,000 (Part of the \$30 million sewer project and being done in conjunction with Streetscape Phase IIIa) was moved to full Council on motion by Walter, seconded by LaStrada. All in favor.
- Rejection of bids for the Sanitary Sewer Collection System Phase 1B Project was moved to full Council on motion by Walter, seconded by Galliher. All in favor.

Finance/Administration Committee – Councilman Turley, Chairman presented the following recommendations:

- Records Destruction Request from the Personnel Department was moved to full Council on motion by Walter, seconded by Galliher. All in favor.
- Bids and Ordinance approving and accepting an agreement with Vital Support Systems, also known as OneNeck IT Solutions (City needs back-up IT services in the event of especially complex computer problems; this service was anticipated in the current budget; costing \$150/hour for total of 40 hours making the total cost \$6,000) was moved to full Council on motion by Rowe, seconded by Monsees. All in favor.
- Quote from World Wide Technologies for the purchase of 25 Dell Desktop Computers in the amount of \$16,325 (replacing computers that have Windows XP which as of April 8, 2014 will no longer be supported) was moved to full Council on motion by Rowe, seconded by LaStrada. All in favor.


Councilman Cross asked to revisit the smoking ordinance since it has been 90 days since its approval. City Attorney, Anne Gardner, stated that if the Council looks at voting again on the smoking ban ordinance, then more information should be obtained from all concerned parties. City Attorney Gardner added that there needs to be a work session so that direction can be given by the Council as to how the smoking ban ordinance should be amended. Then at the following meeting an ordinance could be presented for a Council vote. Mayor Horn suggested that a work session be held February 10, 2014 and then present the ordinance for a formal vote at the March 5, 2014 Council Meeting. Councilman Stevenson objected and stated that the time was too late and added that his decision would be to rescind part of the ordinance to put in that only bars and private clubs can allow smoking. Stevenson would like the work session to be held February 10, 2014 and a council vote at the February 18, 2014 meeting. City Administrator, Gary Edwards, stated that the Council needed to keep in mind that the first budget presentation is scheduled for the February 18, 2014 meeting; however the decision of the meeting dates was at the discretion of the Council. A work session was set for February 10, 2014 to discuss the smoking ordinance and to set a date for a formal vote on the issue.

GOOD & WELFARE:



The second bid was from Bryant Motors of Sedalia was received in the amount of \$52,900.00 for two Dodge Chargers. A third bid was received but it did not meet specifications as it bid two Ford police vehicles.
